

## Our nursery ministry

Little children are an important part of our church family! The Nursery Ministry Committee, volunteers and paid childcare staff members work together to provide a safe, nurturing experience for your child.

On Sunday mornings the nursery is open 8:15-12:30. You must sign your child in and out. The first time, you will complete an information form.

**The nursery area is on the main/2nd floor east hallway of the Jones Building.**

### INFANTS (large room on the left)

Infants up to one year old and walking. We have loving arms to hold and play with your child.

### TODDLERS (Room 211E)

Children one year and walking and two-year-olds. There is a set morning routine with simple Bible stories and activities (with the same themes as two-year-olds). Toddlers transition to the two-year-old class in September and January.

### TWO YEAR OLDS (Room 212E)

Children ages two to three explore Bible stories and have lots of activities. (Children transition into preschool class when they are three and potty-trained.)

## What to bring

Please label all items so that they will not be misplaced.

- \* Bring a diaper bag with a bottle or cup of either formula, breast milk, juice or water.
- \* Bring disposable diapers and a change of clothing.
- \* If your child takes a pacifier, please send it labeled.



## Snack time

**Be sure to note any food allergies on your check-in information!**

Toddlers and two-year-olds get a snack of either graham crackers, animal crackers or goldfish, and apple juice. If your child cannot eat our provided snacks, please send something from home.

## Caring for your child

Our policy is to inform the parent/guardian/partner when a child cries for more than 10 minutes or when a child is sick. We will call or text your cell phone.

## Sick child policy

All rooms are cleaned and disinfected daily.

**Please help us prevent the spread of illnesses by not bringing a sick child to the nursery.**

- \* Children must be fever-free for 24 hours before coming to the nursery.
- \* Children must be free of all vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours before coming to the nursery.
- \* Children with nasal discharge (unless clear) may not come to the nursery.
- \* Children with any kind of a rash (chicken pox, poison ivy, poison oak, etc.) must be past the contagious stages with no open areas before coming to the nursery.
- \* Children with pink eye may come to the nursery when eyes are not running and there is no longer any discharge.
