

the baptized person.



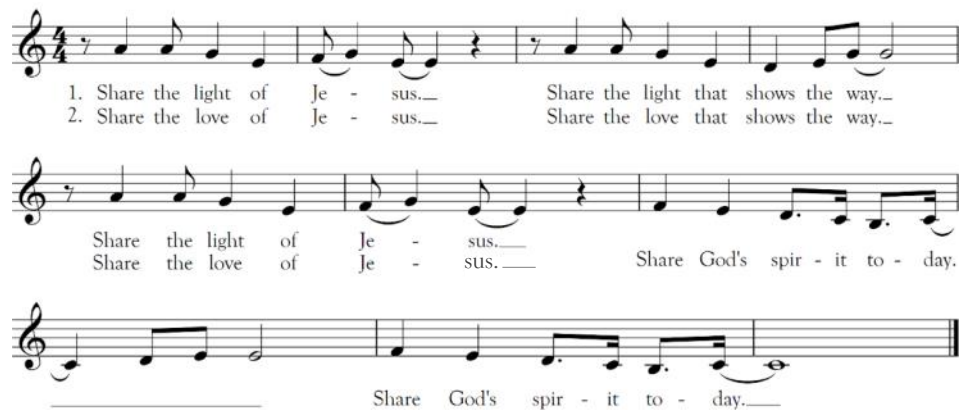
