
Eternal God, as enemies circle and fear grows, the distance between us feels like absence and we come to believe you are hidden and concealed.

Forgive us when we make our faith all about what you might do for us rather than how we might serve you and work towards right relationship with you.




At this time, three-year-olds to kindergarteners are welcome to proceed to the hallway with an adult and sign into Worship and Wonder.
