

# THE BUDGET

Idlewild's budget is a theological document. Just as your household budget communicates your values, how the church allocates its financial resources says a great deal about how we understand and follow the Triune God.

To simplify presentation, we have distilled hundreds of line items down to the six ministry areas that make up our Church's structure. Since we understand our personnel as vital to our ministries, each category includes a proportional percentage of the investment that we make in staff for the ministries of the church (pastoral, administrative, custodial, kitchen, maintenance, and programmatic).

### Takeaways:

- Our top 10 commitments make up 19% of total commitments.
- Our average commitment (\$6,928) continues to increase each year.
- The most significant opportunity for growth is with our members between 30 to 59 years of age, where only 35% of active households make commitments.
